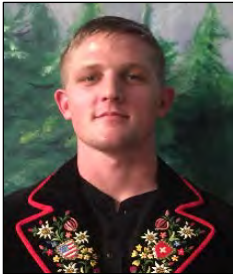


California Schwinger's Heading to Switzerland

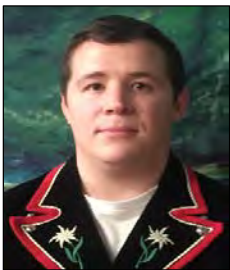

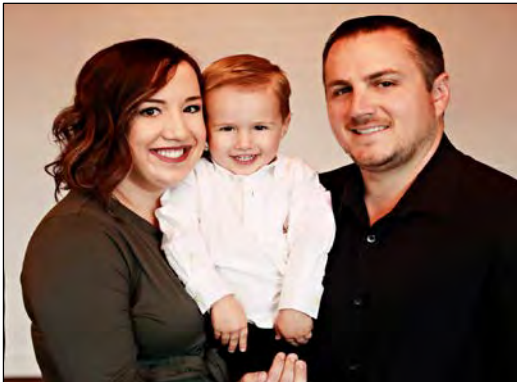

Steinstossen Stone Throw

Steinstossen (stone throwing) is a centuries-old Swiss Alpine traditional sport. Competitors hurl a huge stone in three rounds into a designated area and the winner, being the one throwing his or her stone the longest distance.

Stones used at festivals in Switzerland are of varying sizes and weights, but usually are not much over 100 pounds. The largest stone used is the famed Unspunnen stone weighing 184 pounds which is only used every three years at the Eidgenössisches and every six years at the Unspunnen Festivals.

Swiss Influence in San Diego



Another of San Diego County's larger dairies where Electricity is considered a prime essential is operated by M. Zumstein and Sons.

Have a herd of over 200 Holsteins is milked with Electrically operated milking machines, in an assembly line with bars, probably lighted with fluorescent lights. Several Electric compressors and cooling units are used to chill the milk and to hold it at a low temperature in a 1,000 gallon storage tank until it is taken to market.

Two Electric pumps furnish water under pressure for the cattle, domestic use, and the irrigation of a small plot of alfalfa and permanent pasture.

In the Zumstein residence and the homes of the employees, Electricity is used exclusively for cooking, refrigeration, water heating, and many other purposes.
