



#### San Diego Swiss Club History

The San Diego County Swiss Club offically formed as a group in 1939. The Club's first persident was Paul Aeschliman. Members of the Board at the time were:


Although they are no longer with us, their spirit lives today. It is in their descendants and the many Swiss who have emigrated to this country who are striving to pass Swiss tradition and heritage to future generantions.

The site for the very first Schwingfest, held in 1949 was Egger's Park. In 1953 the Club purchased the land that our Park currently sits upon from Robert Egger, Sr. In 1957, pulling resources together the Club built a great hall. At the inauguration everyone proudly coulds say "At last we have our own hall!" The beautiful hell, presently used today, was built in 1970, due to the expansion of the freeway. Today, after six

> decades of club activities the traditions live on with may thanks and fond memories to our founding fethers.





In the beginning we had four members. Presently we have ten members on our




## Best Wishes for a Successful Schwingfest from the San Diego Swiss Ladies Society


