Schwingen stems back to the middle ages. The first nationally organized Schwingfest was in 1805, "the Unspunnenfest." It was located in the Bernese Alps and is still held every 6 years there to this day. The National Championships, "Eidgenössisches Schwingfest" is held every 3 years in a different city.

The National Schwing Association was founded in 1895. Since then, wrestling has been officially considered a Swiss national sport. Schwingen had increasingly found its way from the Alps to the cities. The alpine farmers or "Sennenschwinger" traditionally from rural areas - wear dark pants with the iconic edelweiss shirt. The "Gymnasts" originating from the cities - wear white pants and shirts.

The wrestlers wear "Schwinghosen" or canvas shorts. The belt is used to take a good grip and the wrestler has to have a hold of the shorts with at least one hand throughout the match. The first person to pin his opponent's back to the ground wins the match.

There are over 120 combinations of grips and moves. The most practiced are... ->

The 4 Judges give a score at the end of each match. A flat throw with your opponent landing on at least 2/3 of his back gives you 10.00 pts. A normal win gives 9.75. An undecided match gives 8.75 but can increase to 9.00 if you have been very active and have wrestled well. A loss will give 8.50 pts but can go up to 8.75.

Schwingen has been around for over 800 years and still continues to boom! In the last few decades, the sport has become increasingly popular, especially with the younger crowds.

There are official traditions followed at every Schwingfest: Before the start of each match, the opponents shake hands as a sign of fairness and respect. The winner then wipes the sawdust off the shoulders & back of his opponent. After 6 rounds of matches, the top two wrestlers compete in the final match, the "Schlussgang." The Champion of the day is then lifted on the shoulders of his teammates to celebrate with the crowd.





"Steinstossen", stone throwing is a centuries-old Swiss Alpine traditional sport. Competitors hurl a huge stone into a designated area. The winner, being the one throwing the stone the longest distance in the best of 3 rounds. Stones used at festivals are of varying weights. The largest stone used is the famed "Unspunnenstein" weighing 184 pounds which is only used every three years at the "Eidgenössisches" Schwingfest and every six years at the "Unspunnenfest".

The Artist Behind the Beautiful Paintings in our Hall

Richard Bamattre (1893-1964) Born in Basel, Switzerland painted the four



paintings hanging in our Swiss Hall, which were originally painted for the Hofer family. Mr. & Mrs. Julius Hofer Sr. generously donated the paintings to our club many years ago, bringing Switzerland into our hall. Richard loved to paint Swiss scenes – the Alps, mountains, lake sceneries, animals and chateaus.

Richard married Martha Fenner in Switzerland and moved to San Francisco. There, Richard worked as foreman of a decorating company. He was transferred to

Los Angeles in 1924, working primarily on churches and theaters. His paintings could be seen in the Warner Brothers Theater, old Los Angeles Theater, the Million Dollar Theater and the Paramount Theater. His paintings grace St. Vincent Church and the Seminary in Montebello, CA. He also did backdrop paintings for movie sets where his wife, Martha, had small acting parts in movies with Gene Kelly and Laurel & Hardy.

Richard and Martha were very active in the Swiss organizations. He was asked to do paintings for the Swiss Halls up and down the state.

His paintings are also on display in the Newark and Ripon Swiss Halls. Another of his works, of the St Bernard Pass, can be found at the St Bernard Lodge in Mill Creek, CA (near Lake Almanor.)



In Remembrance



Max Buchmann (94yrs) - March 20, 1929 ~ June 21, 2024.



Max was born in Mettmerstetten, Zurich, Switzerland and immigrated to the U.S. in 1952. When Max first came to San Diego he worked for Julius Hofer and then, worked on the Dairy Farm for Robert Egger, Sr., a time in which he always spoke fondly. Max was a big supporter of the Swiss Community and President of the San Diego Swiss Club in 1975 and 1976 and was also an Honorary Member of the Club. Max participated in the Pacific Coast Swiss Singing


Paul Odermatt (96yrs) - Oct. 17, 1926 ~ July 10, 2023.
